To: All Persons Under Supervision and General Public
Date: June 19, 2020
Subject: Public and Persons Under Supervision Coronavirus (COVID-19) Protocol

1. If you have returned from travel to a place the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has restrictions on entry to the United States within the last 14 days as presented on the [CDC COVID-19 Travel Recommendations by Country page](#);
2. Or, if you reside or had close contact with someone who traveled to one of the above areas within the last 14 days;
3. Or, if you have been asked to self-quarantine by any hospital or health agency;
4. Or, if you have been diagnosed, or had contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19;
5. Or, symptoms of COVID-19 as presented on the [CDC Symptoms of Coronavirus page](#).

You must advise Probation Staff prior to entering any federal probation or federal court building and prior to contact with probation vendors or probation staff at residence or in the community.

If a Person Under Supervision or member of the public answers yes to any of the above questions they should not enter probation or vendor space, unless it is a medical facility designed to receive people diagnosed, exposed, or possibly exposed to COVID-19. A Person Under Supervision will also need to obtain the appropriate verifications to confirm diagnosis or exposure.

A Person Under Supervision should notify their officer if:

- You or anyone you had contact with has any of the following symptoms: fever, cough, shortness of breath, tiredness, aches, runny nose, or sore throat.
- Or, if you have been diagnosed, or had contact with anyone diagnosed with any infectious disease such as Flu A/B.
